

Terms & Condition of this application

We also do not discriminate against religions or race.

The Wedding Wishing Well Foundation may not be able to cover the whole of your wedding but we will discuss this with you after we receive your application. We will try to fund all or part of your wedding, however we will help with all the organising of your special day.

We can not also full fill the wishes of every single application we receive. We will meet with a board who will discuss a group of applicants and decide who we can help with the team, budget and contacts we have.

Many of the items used at the wedding will remain our property. Items that you are able to keep you will be made aware of. Anything you wish to keep can be purchased from us. Items which are damaged by guests attending your wedding will be charged to the Bride & Groom at the rates set by the supplier. The Wedding Wishing Well Foundation will not be held accountable for any damages that were not their fault. **Where theft of items of damages occur the bride & groom will be charged by the charity for them with no acceptations.**
